### **Experiential & Applied Learning Activities Include:**

- Authorship
- Resource development
- Clinical supervision (receiving & providing)
- Formal certification
- Interactive workshops, trainings, or conferences
- Guest lecturer or speaker
- Clinical consultation
- Formal and informal research
- Volunteer on boards, committees, etc.

### **Independent Learning Activities Include:**

- Reading journal articles, books, case studies, or listening to podcast
- Webinars/Seminars – Recorded or Live
